A Doorstep Green is a multipurpose, community green open space, very close to people's homes and easily accessible to all local community. It should be designed to meet all villager's everyday needs for informal outdoor recreation in pleasant, natural surroundings.

Some ideas: Wildlife area Small orchard

Community garden plot Informal play or games area

Tall grasses Pathway & Benches

The Green will also be designed for sustainable, low cost management, which will involve local people who wish to take an interest in our village life.

What ideas do you have? How would you like the Middle Field to be used by us, the village? The Countryside Agency have informed us that they are recommending Oxborough Doorstep Greens Project for funding at the National Decision Panel meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> December, by which time we must have submitted a completed application form. (This initial funding will be for the development of the Green and then further money e.g. Lottery will be needed to buy the field.)
